SUBJECT: Improvements on Richards Boulevard Between the Southbound I-5 Ramp and North 3rd Street (PN:TB46) - Fund Transfer and Contract Award

SUMMARY

Bids for the Improvements on Richards Boulevard Between the Southbound I-5 Ramp and North 3rd Street project have been received and additional funding of \$100,000 is required to award the contract. Fund transfer and contract award is recommended.

BACKGROUND

This project is designed to decrease traffic congestion on Richards Boulevard in the vicinity of I-5. The project will widen Richards Boulevard from two to four lanes between Bergut Drive and North 3rd Street, install traffic signals at Richards Boulevard and North 3rd Street, modify the traffic signals at the I-5 on and offramps and add a turn lane to the northbound I-5 onramp.

On June 28, 1988, the City Council approved the plans and specifications for this project. Bids were received and opened by the City Clerk on July 19, 1988. The bids received were:

W. Jaxon Baker, Inc.	\$357,126.50
Teichert Construction	\$393,204.00
R. C. Collet, Inc.	\$397,260.50
Granite Construction	\$407,818.00

The engineer's estimated construction cost was \$319,100. The low bid of \$357,126.50 is 11.9% above the estimate.

FINANCIAL

The estimated total project cost, including engineering design and administration, right-of-way acquisition, construction, construction contingencies, inspection, and construction administration is \$585,000. Current funding for this project is as follows:

Major Street Construction	\$450,000	Balance	\$305,600
Capital Grants	<u>35,000</u>	Balance	<u>35,000</u>
Total	\$485,000		\$340,000

Additional funds in the amount of \$100,000 are required for contract award. It is proposed that the additional funds be obtained by defunding the Richards Boulevard and North 10th Street Signal project (PN:SD11) and appropriating \$100,000 to the Improvements on Richards Boulevard Between the Southbound I-5 Ramp and North 3rd Street project.

The Richards Boulevard and North 10th Street Signal project is included in the 1988-89 CIP Program. It is currently budgeted for \$100,000 from Major Street Construction funds. This project is necessary, but we believe it will be funded by the proposed Richards Boulevard Assessment District. If the assessment district is not formed, this project will be resubmitted for budget consideration in future years.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Budget and Finance Committee recommend approval of the defunding and appropriation of funds for this project and forward this report to the full City Council for adoption of the attached resolution.
