On December 22nd, 1981, the City Council adopted its Resolution of Intention to abandon a portion of I and 2nd Streets, subject to reservation of an easement for public utilities.

The abandoned streets are to allow for the expansion of a state park into this area.

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FOR ABANDONMENT PROCEEDING NO. 5181

VACATING PUBLIC EASEMENT PURSUANT TO THE STREET VACATION ACT OF 1941 OF STREETS AND HIGHWAYS CODE OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the City Council of the City of Sacramento requesting vacation of the public streets hereinafter described by vacating a portion of I Street west of 2nd Street and a portion of 2nd Street north of J Street as shown on the plat of the City of Sacramento, filed in the office of the Recorder of Sacramento County.

WHEREAS, this Council did fix the 12th day of January, 1982, at the hour of 7:30 o'clock P. M. of said day, in the Council Chambers of the City Council of the City of Sacramento in the City Hall on I Street between 9th and 10th Streets of said City, as the time and place for hearing said petition and did give due notice thereof as required pursuant to the Street Vacation Act of 1941 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, the said City Council has adopted a Resolution of Intention to vacate the Streets hereinafter described pursuant to Resolution No. <u>81-926</u>, entitled Resolution of Intention for Abandonment Proceeding No. 5181, adopted by the City Council on December 22nd, 1981; and

WHEREAS, said City Council did hear the evidence by

any and all parties interested in said petition; and

WHEREAS, said vacation is declared after due proceedings had therefor according to law and the finding by the City Council which is hereby made, that said Streets are unnecessary for present or prospective use.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That this Council has heretofore adopted it's Engineer's Report and the same is attached hereto and marked Exhibit "A" and incorporated by reference herein.

That the hereinafter described public easement in the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California, be, and the same is hereby ordered vacated:

All that portion of 2nd Street and I Street in the City of Sacramento as shown on the improvement plans filed in the office of the City Engineer entitled "Northwest Corner 2nd and I Streets" and approved by the City Engineer on January 16, 1981, more particularly described as follows:

PARCEL 1

All that portion of I Street as shown on the official map or plan thereof, described as follows: The Northerly 17.5 feet of I Street lying between the Northerly extension of the Westerly right of way line of Commonwealth Avenue (formerly Firehouse Alley) and a point located 188.83 feet, more or less, Easterly therefrom to a point that is located 17.5 feet Easterly of the Westerly right of way line of 2nd Street. Said area includes the gutter and wood sidewalk improvements shown on said improvement plans.

PARCEL 2

All that portion of 2nd Street as shown on the official map or plan thereof, described as follows: A strip of land adjacent to the Westerly right of way line of 2nd Street described as follows: Beginning at a point located on the Northerly right of way line of I Street and lying 17.5 feet Easterly of the Westerly right of way line of 2nd Street; thence from said point of beginning, parallel with the Westerly right of way line of 2nd Street, a distance of 50 feet; thence curving to the right and then to the left on identical reverse curves of 105 feet radius, said curves terminating at a point located 120 feet Northerly from the Northerly right of way line of I Street and 29.5 feet Easterly of the Westerly right of way line of 2nd Street; thence Northerly and parallel with the Westerly right of way line of 2nd Street a distance of 60 feet; thence Northwesterly to a point on the Westerly right of way line of 2nd Street located 196 feet Northerly of the Northerly right of way line of I Street; thence Southerly along the Westerly line of 2nd Street 196 feet to the point of beginning. The area includes the curb and gutter, wood sidewalk and planter area shown on the subject plans.

RESERVING HOWEVER, the right of entry to repair, maintain and construct sewer, water and gas pipes, and aerial or underground power, telephone and other communication facilities now in place in said Streets, or which from time to time may be placed therein. All proceedings in connection with the aforesaid abandonment are to be taken subject to such reservations and exceptions.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a copy of this order, attested by the Clerk of this Council, be recorded in the office of the Recorder of the County of Sacramento.

In the Matter of Abandonment Proceeding No. 5181, Abandonment of a Portion of I Street and 2nd Street in Old Sacramento

ENGINEER'S REPORT

A Public Hearing is scheduled for this date pertaining to the proposed abandonment of I Street lying Westerly of 2nd Street and 2nd Street lying Northerly of I Street.

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This proposed abandonment has been undertaken due to the following facts:

1. The State of California, owners of the abutting property lying north and west of the proposed abandonment requested that the City abandon portions of I Street and 2nd Street adjacent to a State park.

2. That on December 22nd, 1981, the City Engineer presented to the Council the Resolution of Intention for said abandonment, for approval. On that date, the Council did approve said Resolution of Intention, which set a Hearing date on the abandonment for this date.

That Notices of Hearing on the proposed abandonment were posted on the Streets so to be abandoned on <u>December 30th, 1981</u> and said Notice was published in The Daily Recorder on December 28th and 29th, 1981.

3. The purpose of this abandonment is to enable the

State of California to become the owner of said abandoned streets and thereby incorporate said Streets into the existing State park.

4. It is my opinion that said abandonment will not affect teh traffic circulation or aesthetics of the neighborhood.
