

SUMMARY

This report provides information regarding the status of the design of park facility capital improvement projects and requests a part-time Drafting Technician position to augment the park design staff for a six month period.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Department of Parks and Community Services Parks Division is responsible for preparation of park designs and redesigns, a variety of landscape designs including medians and other City property, and project inspections. There are currently 27 FY 1984-85 park projects in the pre-design or design phase and 21 FY 1985-86 projects which are scheduled to begin project design. Attached is a schedule of projects, listed by the year in which they were budgeted, which are waiting design.

In order to expedite the design of these capital improvements projects, it is recommended that a Drafting Technician position augment the existing staff for a six month period. It is estimated that design for 85-90% of the projects can be completed within this fiscal year with the addition of a non-career Drafting Technician. Without the recommended position, only 50 to 60% of the projects will be completed this budget year. Since a significant portion of these projects are Quimby funded, staff recommends utilizing the interest earned from the Quimby Act funds to support this position. State law provides that Quimby interest funds can only be used for the design of projects funded by Quimby funds.

BUDGET AND FINANCE COMMITTEE ACTION

The Budget and Finance Committee, at their meeting of December 17, 1985, voted to approve this item.

FINANCIAL DATA

A .5 FTE Drafting Technician position (N/C) will cost approximately \$15,000. Funding is available from interest earned on the Quimby Act Reserve Fund.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council, by resolution, amend the FY 1985-86 Parks Division operating budget by adding a .5 FTE Drafting Technician position (non-career) and appropriate \$15,000 from the interest earned on the Quimby Act Reserve Funds.
