



How well do you think Sacramento is handling this issue?




Do you know what parental substance abuse is?



"Kids can be **stressed** out very often because parents who have drinking problems often **turn violent or yell, shout, scream** and that can affect the kids."


Our Ide Solution

- CFF (Center for Fathers and Families)








