SUBJECT: Modification of Parking Regulations -- Residential Permit Parking

SUMMARY

This report recommends the modification of Residential Permit Parking regulations in the U. C. Medical Center and Sutter Memorial Hospital Residential Permit Parking areas.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Various inquiries from residents prompted staff to survey the blocks recommended for modification in this report. Residents were surveyed to determine their support for Residential Permit Parking.

The results of the survey were as follows:

U. C. MEDICAL CENTER AREA

T Street, 36th Street to 37th Street - Seven residences are on this portion of T Street; 85.7% have responded in support of Residential Permit Parking regulations with No Parking from 8:00 a.m., to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. (This block was not included in the original Resolution.)

39th Street, S Street to U.S. -50 - Three residences are on this portion of 39th Street. One hundred percent are in support of Residential Permit Parking regulations with No Parking from 8:00 a.m., to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. (This block was not included in the original Resolution.)

V Street, Stockton Boulevard to 39th Street - This portion of V Street currently has Residential Permit Parking with one hour time limits, 8:00 a.m., to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. The two residences have requested these regulations be changed to No Parking, 8:00 a.m., to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, with residential vehicles exempt.

T Street, 39th to 44th Streets - This segment of T Street was left out of the original program in the U. C. Medical Center area due to the residents sending in numerous contradictory petitions. A recent postcard survey stimulated the controversy again, and a petition from the residents contradicted the postcard results. A Neighborhood Meeting will be held on October 2 to try to show these residents their options to help them determine what they want.

39th Street, Downey to Sherman Way - This street was omitted in error on the original Resolution. It is added to the attached U. C. Medical Center Area Resolution as a correction.

Gerber Avenue, between T Street and Downey Way - This was shown in error in the original Resolution as "Between T/Sherman." Correction is shown in the attached U. C. Medical Center Area Resolution.

SUTTER MEMORIAL HOSPITAL AREA

Pico Way, F Street to D Street - There are 28 residences on this street; 60-7% have requested that Residential Permit Parking be removed from this street, because they feel the program is unnecessary for them.

Additional details relating to these surveys are shown on Attachment I.

FINANCIAL DATA

The total cost of implementing these proposals is itemized as follows:

Annual operating cost increase will be negligible.

RECOMMENDATIONS

It is recommended that the attached Resolution modifying Residential Permit Parking regulations in the U. C. Medical Center area and Sutter Memorial Hospital area be adopted.

RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 79-835, FOR
MODIFICATIONS OF PARKING REGULATIONS WITHIN THE
U. C. MEDICAL CENTER RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING
AREA.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

Pursuant to Section 25.185 of the Sacramento City Code, Pico Way between F Street and D Street is hereby eliminated from the Sutter Memorial Hospital Area Residential Permit Parking area.

Pursuant to Sections 25.174 of the Sacramento City Code, the area known as the U. C. Medical Center area as shown on the attached map was established as a Residential Permit Parking area. Parking on the public streets within the area boundaries, as shown on the attached map, shall be regulated by various parking restrictions. Vehicles which display valid Residential Parking Permits or Visitor Parking Permits issued for use in the U. C. Medical Center area, shall be exempt from said parking time restrictions.

Residential Parking Permits shall be issued to each residential vehicle of the area, upon application by the resident owner to the office of the Traffic Engineer. Current vehicle ownership registration, issued by the State of California, shall be required as proof of residential vehicle ownership and residence. Each residence shall be entitled to one Visitor Permit upon application by the respective resident to the office of the Traffic Engineer and by showing proof of residence in the area by current California vehicle ownership registration, a current California driver's license, or other proof as deemed appropriate by the Traffic Engineer. Said Residential Permits and Visitor Permits shall be valid for one full year from the date of issuance. Additional temporary Visitor Permits may be issued to area residents by application to the office of the Traffic Engineer. Said temporary Visitor Permits shall be issued at the discretion of the Traffic Engineer.

The following public streets in the U. C. Medical Center area shall be regulated by one hour time limits from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Vehicles displaying Residential or Visitor Parking Permits issued for use in the U. C. Medical Center area shall be exempt from all parking time limits.

South side of "U" between Stockton/west of "29th"
North side of "V" between Stockton/"39th"
East side of "39th" between "V"/"T."

The following public streets in the U. C. Medical Center area shall be regulated by two hour time limits from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Vehicles displaying Residential or Visitor Parking Permits issued for use in the U. C. Medical Center area shall be exempt from said parking time limits.

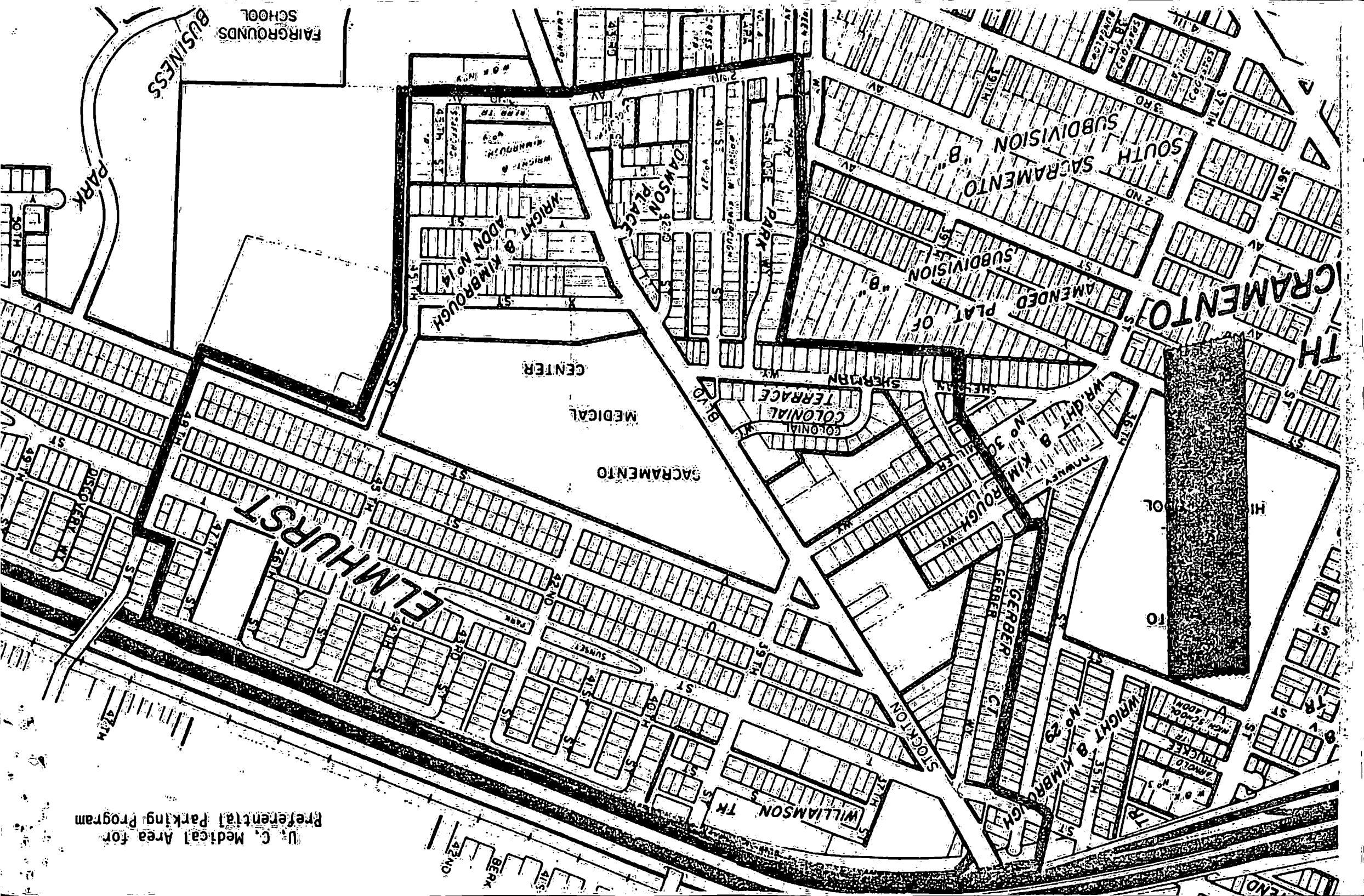
All existing red, yellow, blue, white and green zones shall remain in effect if located on any of the public streets as referenced herein for Residential Permit Parking.

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 79-317, ELIMINATING PICO WAY FROM THE SUTTER MEMORIAL RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

Pursuant to Section 25.185 of the Sacramento City Code, Pico Way between F Street and D Street, is hereby eliminated from the Sutter Memorial Hospital area Residential Permit Parking area.

Pursuant to Sections 25.174 of the Sacramento City Code, the area known as the Sutter Memorial Hospital area, as shown on the attached map, was established as a Residential Permit Parking area on May 22, 1979. Residential Parking Permits shall be issued to each residential vehicle of the area, upon application by the resident-owner to the office of the Traffic Engineer. Current vehicle ownership registration, issued by the State of California, shall be required as proof of residential vehicle ownership and residence. Each residence shall be entitled to one Visitor Permit upon application by the respective resident to the office of the Traffic Engineer and by showing proof of residence in the area by current California vehicle ownership registration, a current California Driver's License, or other proof as deemed appropriate by the Traffic Engineer. Said Residential Permits and Visitor Permits shall be valid for one full year from the date of issuance. Additional, temporary Visitor Permits may be issued to area residents by application to the office of the Traffic Engineer. Said temporary Visitor Permits shall be issued at the discretion of the Traffic Engineer.

The following public streets in the Sutter Memorial Hospital area shall be regulated by 2 hour time limits from 8:00 a.m., to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday (from which Residential Permits and Visitor Parking Permits shall be exempt), as follows:

Parking shall be prohibited, from 10:00 a.m., to 6:00 p.m., every day of the year on "E" Street from Coloma Way to the Sutter Memorial Hospital property; those vehicles which display Residential Parking Permits or Visitor Parking Permits issued for use in the Sutter Memorial Hospital area shall be exempt from said prohibitions.

All existing red, yellow, blue, white and green zones within any of the blocks listed herein shall remain in effect.
