SUMMARY

This report concerns the proposed changes in library open hours resulting from the approved 1983/84 library budget. Martin Luther King, Jr. Regional Library would close Mondays and the Central Library would carry a reduced six day schedule. (See chart attached for specific hours.) Total hours reduction from 409 to 384.

BACKGROUND

A total of 6.4 FTE non-career public service positions were eliminated to meet the status quo budget. Of these positions 4.4 FTE were assigned to maintain hours at King Regional and Central Libraries. Two FTE positions which cover vacations and on-call emergency coverage were eliminated. This may result in closures of smaller branches and reduced service levels at larger units during periods of vacation and/or sick leave usage.

FINANCIAL DATA

This year's target budget, although an increase over last year, is not sufficient to maintain the same level of employees and service hours as last year. All non-career positions (1 FTE Librarian I; .5 FTE Typist Clerk; 3.9 FTE Library Assistant I; 1 FTE Library Page) were eliminated, including those added in January 1983 to open Martin Luther King, Jr. Regional Library and in 1978/79 to open Central Library on Saturday.

RECOMMENDATION

The Library recommends the attached library open hours to begin August 22, 1983. Instead of closing Central Library on Saturday, as originally proposed, the Library proposes half day coverage on Mondays and Saturdays. This will accommodate business persons on Mondays and students and families from outside the downtown area on Saturdays.
