SUBJECT: EMERGENCY LOWERING OR SUSPENSION OF CITY FEES AND CHARGES 1985

SUMMARY

This report recommends that the City Council grant authority to the City Manager to lower or suspend the City's fees and charges for services in certain circumstances.

BACKGROUND

The City Council, by resolution, determines the various fees and charges for City services. The fees and charges for all City services are listed in the City's Fee and Charge Report, which has become an accepted reference source for City billings.

DISCUSSION

From time to time, the fees and charges adopted by the City Council may become inappropriate on a temporary basis. An example of such a situation is the impairment of the Land Park Golf Course due to City capital improvements. The City Council approved fees are not appropriate due to construction activity which prohibits play on a portion of the course. City Council approval for a temporary fee and charge decrease requires approximately thirty days to implement.

Presently, the City Manager is authorized to make budget transfers up to a maximum of \$20,000 per occurrence. A similar dollar authority should be granted for temporary fee and charge decreases on an emergency basis for a period not to exceed thirty days.

RECOMMENDATION


It is recommended that the City Council adopt the attached resolution authorizing the City Manager to lower or suspend the City's fees and charges for services in certain circumstances.
