SUBJECT: ADOPTION OF AGREEMENT AUTHORIZING CABLE TV EMERGENCY RECONNECTIONS

SUMMARY

This report recommends that the City Council adopt the attached resolution which authorizes the Mayor to execute an agreement for the Reactivation of Standby Power Supplies for Cable Television.

BACKGROUND

The Sacramento Municipal Utilities District (SMUD) procedures require, in those instances where the cable television system's existing power supply is placed out of service due to automobile accidents or other incidents, that the responsible local government entity inspect and approve the repair work prior to reactivating the power supply. Sacramento Cable Television (SCT) has experienced delays in reactivating their system when incidents occur during nights and weekends when the various governmental entities' inspectors are not readily available to inspect the repair work. The attached agreement will allow SCT to contact SMUD to perform emergency reconnection and reactivation without first obtaining inspection by the responsible governmental entity. As a part of the agreement SCT agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Cities and County for any liability arising from reconnection prior to inspection. In addition, the respective inspectors of the entities having jurisdiction will conduct the post-reconnection and reactivation inspection on an expedient basis.

This agreement was approved by the Cable Commission on February 2, 1989, the County of Sacramento on May 9, 1989, and is also being executed by the cities of Folsom and Galt. The Sacramento Municipal Utilities District representatives have reviewed the agreement and will become a signatory following execution by each of the governmental entities.


RECOMMENDATION
