

ORDINANCE NO. 81, FOURTH SERIES.

An Ordinance amending Section 1 of Ordinance No. 27, Fourth Series, passed November 3, 1921, and entitled, "An Ordinance providing for the Police Department of the City of Sacramento, designating the officers, members and attaches thereof; defining their duties; fixing their compensation; and repealing Ordinance No. 337, Third Series, passed June 11th, 1918; Ordinance No. 345, Third Series, passed August 1st, 1918; and Ordinance No. 6, Fourth Series, passed June 30th, 1921;" also adding a new Section to said Ordinance to be numbered Section 2-1/2, providing for a Superintendent of the Traffic Bureau; also adding a new section to said Ordinance to be numbered Section 3-1/2, creating a Traffic Bureau for the City and describing the duties of the officers thereof, and also amending Section 8 of said Ordinance, providing for the compensation of the members of the Police Department.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

Section 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 27, Fourth Series, passed November 3, 1921, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. The Police Department of the City of Sacramento shall consist of a Chief of Police, an Inspector of Police, a Captain of Police and a Police Force consisting of three (3) Desk Sergeants, one (1) Relief Desk Sergeant, four (4) Detective Sergeants, one (1) Relief Detective Sergeant, three (3) Corporals, a Superintendent of the Bureau of Criminal Identification, who shall have the rank of Captain, an Assistant to the Superintendent of the Bureau of Criminal Identification, and a Clerk to the Superintendent of the Bureau of Criminal Identification, a Superintendent of the Traffic Bureau, and sixty-five (65) patrolmen.

The above Relief Desk Sergeant and Relief Detective Sergeant shall receive the same pay as that allowed a regular sergeant, and in addition to acting as Relief Sergeants they shall perform such other duties as may be assigned to them by the Chief of Police.

Provided, that during the disability of any member of the Police Department, an extra Policeman may be appointed to serve during such disability, and while so serving, such extra Policeman shall receive the same compensation as is by ordinance provided to be paid to the officer in whose place such extra Policeman is serving.
