**ORDINANCE NO. 97-003**

ADOPTED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL

ON DATE OF JAN 14 1997

**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTION LIMITS CODE, CHAPTERS 62.02 THROUGH 62.05, INCLUSIVE, OF TITLE 62 OF THE CITY CODE, SAVE AND EXCEPT AS TO ACTS OCCURRING ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 1996; AND DECLARING THE ORDINANCE TO BE AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.**

Except as provided in Section 2 of this ordinance, Chapters 62.02 through 62.05 of Title 62 of the City Code, inclusive, consisting of City Code Sections 62.02.200 through 62.05.232, are hereby repealed.

**Section 2.**

Notwithstanding Section 1 of this ordinance, the provisions of Chapters 62.02 through 62.05 of Title 62 of the City Code, inclusive, as they exist on the effective date of this ordinance, shall continue to be operative and effective with regard to any acts occurring on or before December 31, 1996.

**Section 3.**

This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance to take effect immediately. The facts constituting the emergency are: Proposition 208, which substantially amended the California Political Reform Act (Government Code Sec. 81000 et seq.) and which contains provisions which conflict with the provisions of the City of


