SUBJECT: North Natomas Water Transmission Main - Phase II (PN:ZC31) -  
Project Approval and Bid Advertisement

SUMMARY

Plans and specifications for this project have been prepared. Approval of the plans and specifications and authorization to advertise for bids is recommended.

BACKGROUND

This project will extend the North Natomas Water Transmission Main from the pump station located just northeast of the crossing of Interstates 5 and 80 to Arco Arena Boulevard, a distance of approximately 4300 feet. The water main will be constructed using 36 inch diameter concrete pipe.

A Negative Declaration for this project was filed with the County Clerk of the County of Sacramento on December 12, 1989 . The engineer's estimated construction cost is \$759,000.

FINANCIAL DATA

Sufficient funds are available for this project. The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design and construction costs, is \$872,800. The current budget is \$3,400,000, which was approved in the Capital Improvement Program from the Water Fund (413). The funds available for this project amount to \$1,021,000, as of June 4, 1991.

A non-refundable fee of \$15.00 will be charged for each set of plans and specifications to cover reproduction costs.


RECOMMENDATION

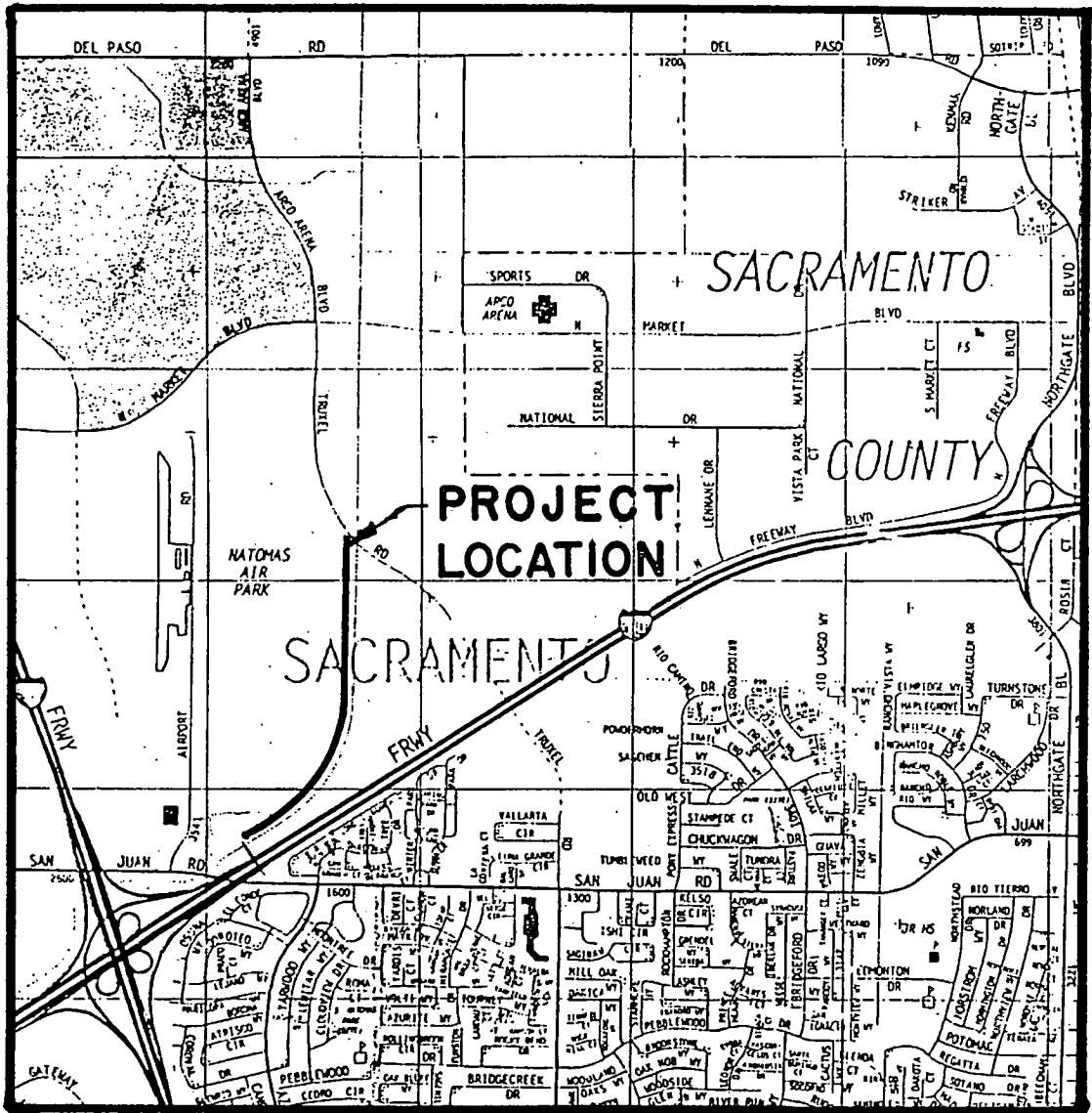
