SUMMARY

The Local Assistance Officer of Caltrans has unencumbered funds available for select cities to use on Pavement Marking Demonstration projects. The staff requests approval to apply for these funds.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The City of Sacramento has previously requested and received approval for two Pavement Marking Demonstration Grants. One grant was for the installation of raised pavement markers, and the other grant was for thermo-plastic striping which is a durable, long-life marking material.

As part of the thermo-plastic grant, the City purchased and was reimbursed for thermo-plastic application equipment. This application would be for cold plastic and thermo-plastic on new or recently surfaced streets to get the maximum striping life which ranges from 7 to 10 years under normal circumstances.

A contractor would be retained for certain applications and City forces would be doing other applications.

FINANCIAL DATA

Caltrans has indicated that \$200,000 may be available for this grant which provides for 100% reimbursement to the City.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council approve the staff request to submit this grant to Caltrans.
