SUBJECT: K Street Pedestrian Underpass Recommendation on Award of Bid

SUMMARY

The subject project, part of the City's Capitol Improvement Program, was advertised for bids, and one bid was received. Recommendation of award was delayed until an analysis of the project and bid could be made. It is recommended that a contract be awarded to the low bidder, and that certain items of the contract be modified to reduce the cost and provide for simplified maintenance.

BACKGROUND

On May 20, 1980, the City Council approved plans and specifications for K Street Pedestrian Underpass and one bid was received and opened by the City Clerk in the Council Chambers on June 24, 1980. The bid received is as follows:

Since the base bid less deductive alternates was 17% above the engineer's estimate of \$150,000.00, an analysis of the project elements was made to determine what adjustments could be made in order to reduce the cost without basically altering the concept of the design. During this analysis several changes were also made to reduce future maintenance costs. It was determined that \$6,012.00 could be deducted from the contract cost by making minor changes in the design.

FUNDING

Funding is available for this project from Project 4 Tax Increment Funds. See the attached estimated project cost sheet.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the low bid of M & M Electric, less the deductive alternates, and less the cost of minor changes to the design, be accepted as follows:

Less Deductive Alternates	-10,000

It is further recommended that the attached Change Order No. 1 be approved simultaneously with the award of the construction contract, and that the attached Resolutions be adopted:

- 1. Authorizing payment to the City from Project 4 Tax Increment Funds.
- 2. Finding benefits to Project 4.


