SUMMARY:

The Public Works Department recommends that the selection committee established to evaluate private waste-to-energy proposals consist of (1) a City Councilmember, (2) a member of the California Energy Commission, (3) a member of the City/County Solid Waste Advisory Committee, (4) a City Finance Department member and (5) a City Public Works staff member.

BACKGROUND:

The Public Works Department has received statements of qualifications from 12 private firms that indicated their interest in submitting proposals to the City to license design, construct and operate a waste-to-energy facility.
