

SUMMARY

The Sacramento Elderly Nutrition Program (SENP) presently serves approximately 1,100 meals per day to seniors in Sacramento City and County. The meals are prepared and delivered by SmorgaBob's under a catering contract. The current contract period will expire on July 31, 1980, the time when SENP's new Central Kitchen was scheduled to go into operation.

#### BACKGROUND

SENP has been mandated by its grantor agency, Area 4 Agency on Aging, to postpone the start-up of the Central Kitchen and explore the feasibility of leasing the kitchen facility to a food production organization rather than operating it on their own, in an attempt to reduce costs. The Program has made initial research efforts and contacts in this regard, but progress has been slow because of (1) a local and area-wide total absence of a model-type operation, and (2) absence of technical know-how and assistance, both within the Program and by recommended outside organizations. It appears that a thorough and valid feasibility study cannot be completed within the prescribed time limit (August 31, 1980).

SENP is required to maintain services while the issues of its funding needs and leasing versus operating of the Central Kitchen are pending. In order to guarantee continuity of services, an extension of the caterer contract is required to allow sufficient time for a resolution of the problems and subsequent transition from the catered services to either self-operation or outside operation of the Central Kitchen.

An extension of the caterer contract through December 31, 1980, with an option to terminate it sooner upon a 30-day notice, is requested.

### FINANCIAL DATA

The total cost for the caterer service from August through December, 1980, will be approximately \$145,530. Funds for these services are available under the Program's approved 1980-81 operating budget, including Title III-C Older Americans Act grants and a supplementary County General Fund grant.

There will be no additional personnel required as a result of this contract extension.
