

SUBJECT: Traffic Signal and Street Lighting Systems at West El Camino and Gateway Oaks Drive (JN:1447) - Resolution Amending the Capital Improvement Program, Increasing Revenue Budget, Appropriation of Funds and Transfer of Funds

#### SUMMARY

Plans and specification have been prepared for this project. Amendment of the CIP Program to include project approval, an increase in the revenue budget and appropriation and transfer of funds is recommended.

#### BACKGROUND

A traffic signal system is to be installed at West El Camino and Gateway Oaks Drive pursuant to condition (M) of Resolution No. 84-156, which approved the tentative map for the Capital Business Center (Metropolitan Center).

#### FINANCIAL

A condition of the tentative map approval required the developers to deposit the sum of \$69,525 with the City. That amount was received on February 23, 1988 (Cash Receipt No. 24377, 101-310-3136-3651 - JN:1447) and subsequently was deposited to Capital Grants (248-310-3136-3709 - JN:1447). This represents 50% of the estimated total cost of the traffic signal.

It is proposed the CIP Program be amended to include this project and the Capital Grants revenue budget be increased by \$69,525. It is further proposed \$69,525 be transferred from the South Natomas Community Improvement Fund to the Traffic Signal and Street Lighting Systems at West El Camino and Gateway Oaks Drive (PN:1447) project as shown in the attached resolution.


