SUBJECT: Recommendation to modify the State Capitol Residential Permit Parking Area by adding the east side of 11th Street between N Street and the N/O alley to the program

SUMMARY

This report recommends the addition of the 11th Street, east side, between the N Street and N/O alley.

BACKGROUND

Residents of 11th Street, from N Street to the N/O alley have submitted a petition, representing 54% of the addressed units requesting the addition of a portion of 11th Street between N Street and N/O alley to the State Capitol Residential Permit Parking Program. Parking conditions have been surveyed and results show a peak period curb occupancy of 100%. Based on the petition and survey data, it is recommended that 11th Street east side, between N Street and the N/O alley be included in the State Capitol Residential Permit Program.

A RESOLUTION MODIFYING RESOLUTION NO. 82-694 BY ADDING A CERTAIN STREET SEGMENT TO THE STATE CAPITOL RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING PROGRAM

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

Pursuant to Section 25.185 of the Sacramento City Code, it is recommended that the public street in the State Capitol Residential Permit Parking Area be regulated by two hour parking meters from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Sundays and Holidays excepted. Vehicles displaying residential or visitor permits issued for use in the State Capitol Area shall be exempt from said two-hour time limit.
