SUBJECT: Construction of a Running Track at Curtis Park (PN:LD66) - Contract Award

SUMMARY

This project has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and contract award is recommended.

BACKGROUND

This project will construct a decomposed granite running track around the perimeter of Curtis Park on an existing dirt trail worn in by the Curtis Park runners.

On September 6, 1988, the City Council approved the plans and specifications for this project. Bids were received and opened by the City Clerk on September 27, 1988. The bids received were:

Harris Duley Landscape and Maintenance	\$41,538.44
Altman, J.R., General Engineering Contractor	\$67,510.00

The architect's estimated construction cost was \$78,000. The estimated project completion date is March 1, 1989.

FINANCIAL

Sufficient funds are available for this project. The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design and construction costs, is \$51,600. The current budget is \$112,000, which was approved in the Capital Improvement Program from Capital Grants Funds (248) from the 1986 State Park Bond Act. The funds available for this project amount to \$111,000 as of October 20, 1988.


It is recommended that the City Council accept the low bid of Harris Duley Landscape and Maintenance in the amount of \$41,538.44, and award the contract.
