Honoring the 50th Anniversary of Theodore Judah Elementary School

WHEREAS, in 1926 the residents of the McKinley neighborhood wanted their own neighborhood elementary school; and

WHEREAS, the mothers of the neighborhood organized and took their concerns to the Sacramento City School Board who decided to establish a temporary Theodore Judah Elementary School in 1927 in a single room bungalow; and

WHEREAS, Theodore Judah Elementary School grew slowly during the next several years as times were difficult due to the depression and world unrest, but the community continued to work together in the interest of their children; and

WHEREAS, in April of 1939, Theodore Judah Elementary School, as we know it today was completed and inspected on April 21, 1939, almost 13 years after the purchase of the land.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and the Council of the City of Sacramento that we hereby honor Theodore Judah Elementary School on its 50th Anniversary, and extend our best wishes to all who will be participating in the celebration of this historically significant event.
