

SUBJECT: Revocable Encroachment Permit - Kin Shaw Wong and Diana M. Wong,

et al

SUMMARY:

Kin Shaw Wong and Diana M. Wong, et al has applied for a revocable encroachment permit for the purpose of landscaping, irrigation and appurtenances. The City Engineer recommends that the permit be granted.

BACKGROUND:

The area for which this request is being made consists of an area approximately 14' x 115' adjacent to County A.P.N. 25-081-01, City address 2700 Fruitridge Road from back of sidewalk along embankment to property line.

RECOMMENDATION:

RESOLUTION GRANTING REVOCABLE ENCROACHMENT TO:

Kin Shaw Wong and Diana M. Wong, et al

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That a revocable encroachment permit for the purpose of landscaping, irrigation and appurtenances

is hereby granted to Kin Shaw Wong and Diana M. Wong, et al , whose address is as follows: 2207 16th Street, P.O. Box 57, Sacramento, CA 95818.

The encroachment area is described as follows: An area adjacent to County A.P.N. 25-081-01 and City address 2700 Fruitridge Road. An area from back of sidewalk along embankment to property line approximately $14' \times 115'$.

This permit is granted subject to the "General Provisions - Revocable Encroachment Permit", which were adopted by the City Council in Resolution No. 77-611, dated October 4, 1977, and the hereinafter specified special conditions, if any. This permit shall be effective only after the applicant files with the Department of Finance of the City of Sacramento, the insurance certificates required by the General Provisions.



SPECIAL CONDITIONS

- 1. The permittee shall comply with requirements of the City Planning Department, the Building Inspections, and the City Sign Ordinance.
- 2. Landscaping shall meet all height restrictions set by code or as required by the City Traffic Engineer to maintain visibility. Permittee assumes all liability thereof.
