SUMMARY

This project has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and contract award is recommended.

BACKGROUND

This project will remove and reconstruct the existing combination sewer line and appurtenances in the I-J Alley from 10th Street to 11th/12th Streets. This replacement of the deteriorated sewer is an activity proceeding the construction of the Civic Center Plaza Garage structure.

On April 17, 1990, the City Council approved the plans and specifications for this project. Bids were received and opened by the City Clerk on May 15, 1990. The bids received were:

The engineer's estimated construction cost was \$130,000. The estimated project completion date is September 15, 1990.

FINANCIAL DATA

Sufficient funds are available for this project. The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design and construction costs, is \$125,000. The current budget is \$185,700, which was approved in the

City Council  
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Capital Improvement Program from Sewer Fund (414). The funds available for this project amount to \$173,000, as of May 14, 1990.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS

This action is consistent with Chapter 58, Article III, Section 58.304 of the City Code involving award of a contract.


MBE/WBE EFFORTS

Plans and specifications were sent to nineteen (19) plan rooms and construction services organizations for publication and use by the construction industry of Northern California. There are four (4) organizations on the distribution list that are directly involved with MBE/WBE contractors. There were fifteen (15) planholders for this project, none of whom are certified MBE/WBE contractors.


RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council accept the low bid of Sacramento Excavator in the amount of \$89,510, and award the contract.



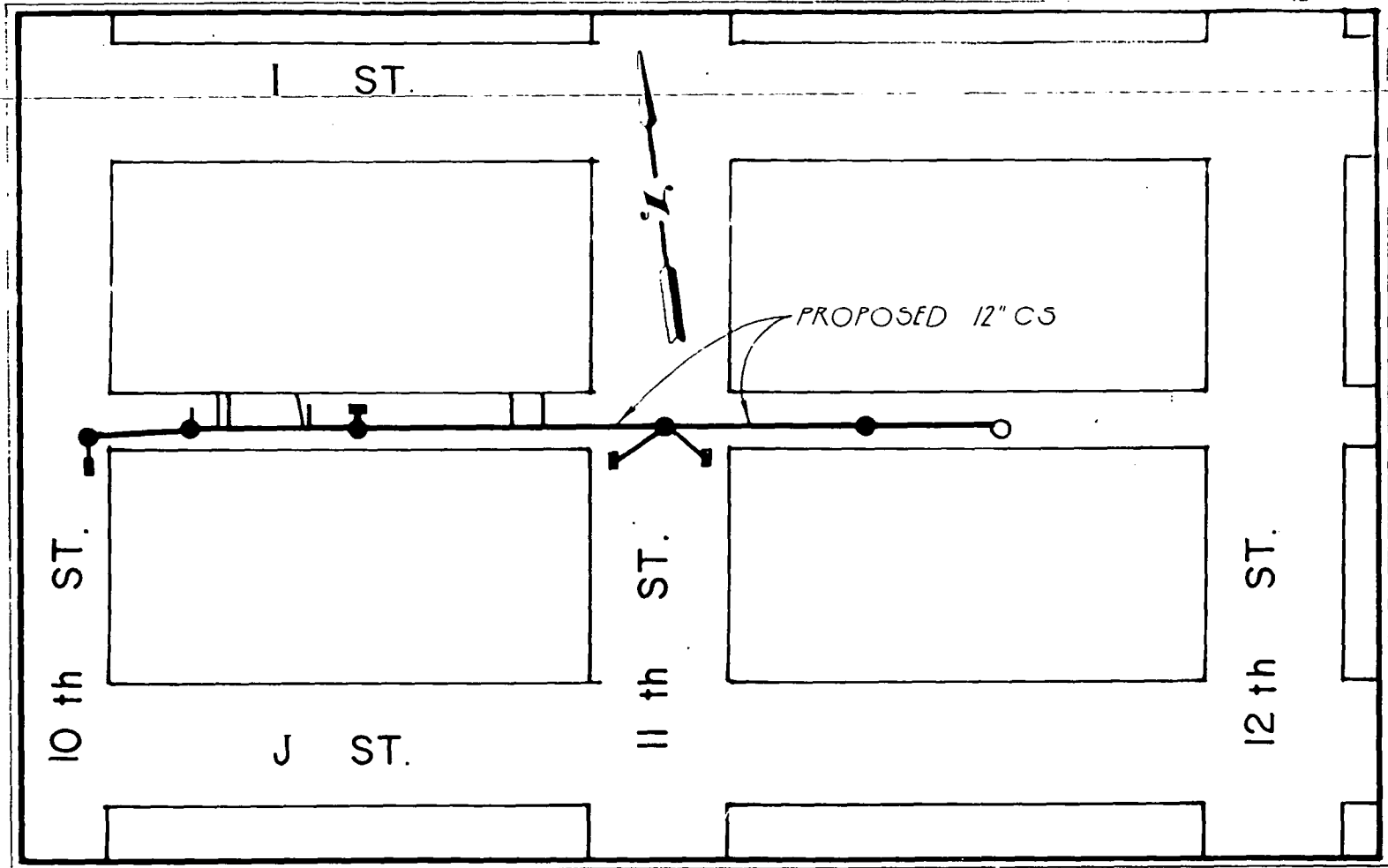
