SUBJECT: Appeal of Carlton Z. Adams from the Decision of the Police Department regarding Operation of Coin-Operated Machines at Carl's Pizza

SUMMARY

Attached is the appeal of Carlton Z. Adams from the decision of the Police Department regarding operation of coin-operated machines at Carl's Pizza, as required by Section 5.31 of the Sacramento City Code.

BACKGROUND

Under Sections 2.323 and 2.324 of the City Code, the Council may appoint a hearing examiner to hear the appeal if it finds that "the appeal may involve a lengthy factfinding process which would be more appropriately accommodated by a formal hearing before a hearing examiner."

FINANCIAL DATA

The estimated cost would be \$100.00 and would be available from the Police Department budget.

RECOMMENDATIONS
