

ORDINANCE NO. 454, FOURTH SERIES.

An Ordinance authorizing the City to purchase two chlorine dosing machines and dosing equipment for use at the filtration plant, without first advertising for bids, and making this Ordinance an emergency measure to take effect immediately.


BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

Section 1. The proper purchasing authorities of the City of Sacramento are hereby authorized and directed to purchase, for and on behalf of the City of Sacramento, two chlorine dosing apparatuses and necessary equipment for use at the filtration plant, without first advertising for bids, such course having been recommended by the City Manager.

Section 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately, such emergency existing by reason of the danger of failure of the present chlorine dosing apparatus at the filtration plant, and the hazard which would exist as a consequence of such failure, which would necessitate pumping raw water untreated into the water mains of the City of Sacramento.
