

ORDINANCE NO. 1152, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1060, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED JUNE 29, 1945, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING OUT OF THE REVENUES OF THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JULY 1, 1945, THE AMOUNTS NECESSARY TO MEET THE EXPENDITURES OF THE CITY BASED ON THE BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JULY 1, 1945, SUBMITTED BY THE CITY MANAGER, AND MAKING THIS AN EMERGENCY MEASURE," AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: There is hereby appropriated to "SALARIES AND WAGES" Division of Trees - Park Department, Budget No. 56, from Lines 2, 3 and 4 of said Budget, the following sums:

From Line No. 2.....	\$	100.00
From Line No. 3.....		1300.00
From Line No. 4.....		1100.00

SECTION 2: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately, being an ordinance appropriating money.
