Honoring William P. Carnazzo On the Occasion of His Retirement

WHEREAS, William P. Carnazzo began working for the City of Sacramento as a Deputy City Attorney in 1979, advancing to the position of Chief Assistant City Attorney; and

WHEREAS, throughout his twenty-four years of distinguished service, Mr. Carnazzo has provided legal representation of the highest quality on thousands of matters large and small, and has built a reputation as one of the outstanding municipal attorneys in the State; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Carnazzo is recognized as an expert on public financing law, and for many years has led the City Attorney's Office's involvement in development of the financing mechanisms, infrastructure planning and regulatory compliance needed for development of the North Natomas area, which eventually is expected to add over 60,000 new residents to the City; and

WHEREAS, in addition to his many administrative duties in the City Attorney's Office, Mr. Carnazzo's skill and leadership have played a key role in the construction of numerous complex and significant projects in the downtown area and throughout the City, including the development of the California EPA office building at 10th and I Streets, the Sheraton Grand Hotel project on J Street, and the City Hall expansion project currently under construction; and






