SUBJECT: Traffic Signals and Improvements at San Juan Road and  
Bridgeford Drive (PN:SG11) - Contract Award

SUMMARY

This project has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and contract award is recommended.

BACKGROUND

This project will install traffic signals at the intersection of San Juan Road and Bridgeford Drive. Also included will be the installation of street lights, pedestrian actuated walk lights and handicap ramps. Completion of the project will provide better control of vehicular flow and improve safety for both vehicles and pedestrians.

This will be the fifth set of traffic signals installed using Measure A (One Half Cent Sales Tax Program) funds.

On September 18, 1990, the City Council approved the plans and specifications for this project. Bids were received and opened by the City Clerk on October 16, 1990. The bids received were:

May-Han Electric, Inc., dba M&M Electric	\$102,222
Community Electric, Inc.	\$123,756
Richard A. Heaps Electrical Contractors, Inc.	\$124,657
Steiny and Company, Inc.	\$130,259
Grason Electric Co.	\$145,455

The engineer's estimated construction cost was \$108,000. The estimated project completion date is May 1, 1991.

FINANCIAL DATA

Sufficient funds are available for this project. The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design and construction costs, is \$142,800. The current budget is \$150,000, which was approved in the Capital Improvement Program from Sacramento Transportation Sales Tax (201).

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS

This action is consistent with Chapter 58, Article III, Section 58.304 of the City Code concerning award of contracts.

MBE/WBE EFFORTS

Plans and specifications were sent to nineteen (19) plan rooms and construction services organizations for publication and use by the construction industry of Northern California. There are four (4) organizations on the distribution list that are directly involved with MBE/WBE contractors. There were ten (10) planholders for this project, none of whom are listed as certified MBE/WBE contractors.


RECOMMENDATION

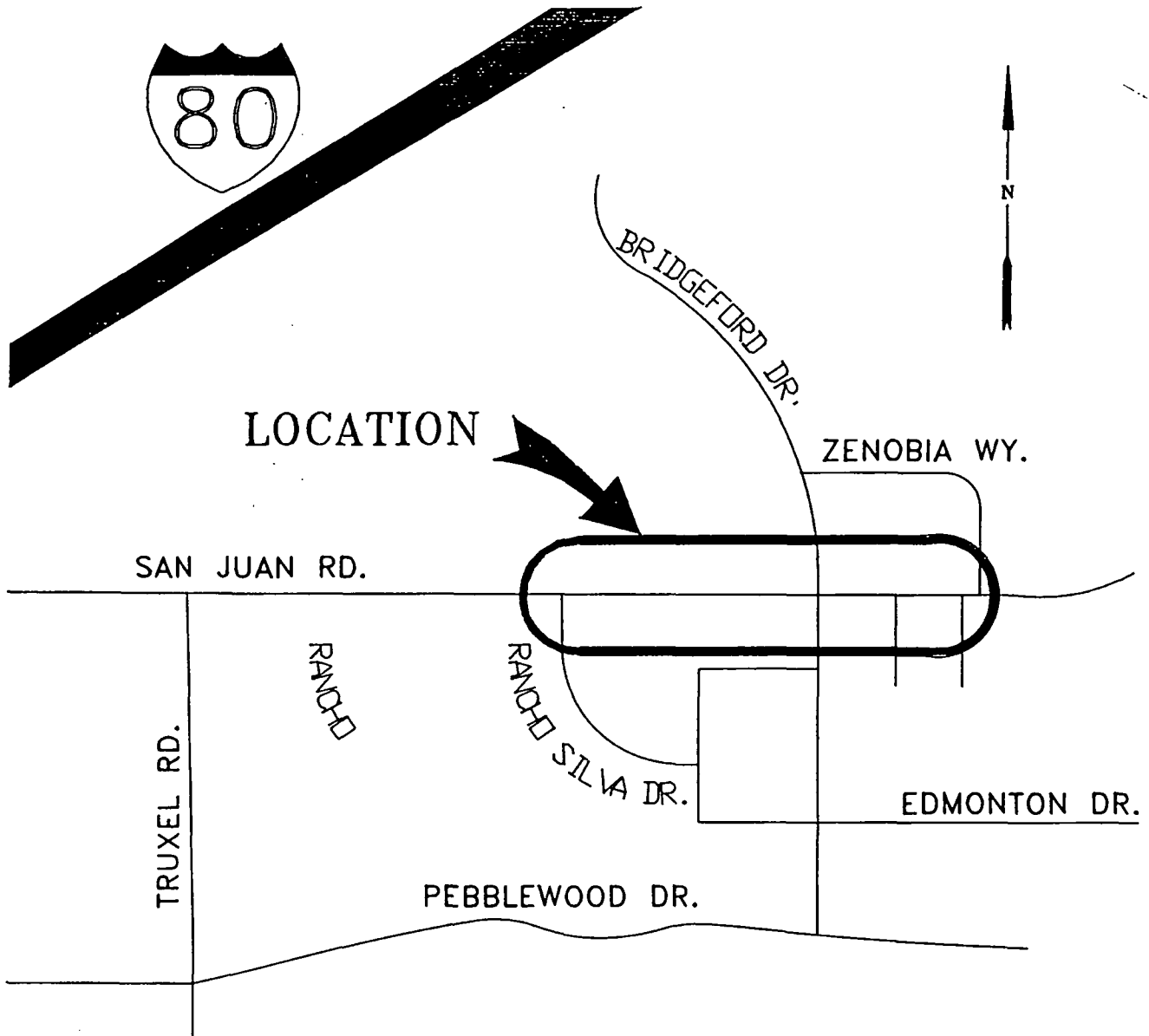
