


## Background

- Environmental education increases awareness, knowledge and promotes critical thinking and problem solving skills.







Over 92% of the teachers reported that their students showed interest in helping the planet.




100% of teachers surveyed expressed agreement that students would benefit from engaging climate activities.




Nearly 80% of the students expressed interest in educating younger generation on climate related topics.

- Presented at booths at community events (like Earth Day fairs, community fairs, farmers markets, and more)




