SUMMARY

The attached resolution approves leases with the following tenants for occupancy in retail space at Garage G, between 3rd and 4th Streets on the K Mall.

BACKGROUND

The Agency advertised the availability of four retail units in Garage G during the month of April in local papers. Of the four proposals subsequently received, the SHR Commission liked three, but directed staff to readvertise for an additional two week period. The San Francisco Examiner was utilized besides local papers. No more proposals were received as a result of the advertisements so the Commission selected the above three tenants with direction to the staff to continue seeking a prestigious type tenant for the remaining prime space of 1,352 sq.ft.

The fourth proposal submitted was from a Mr. Peter Navin, a custom haberdasher doing tailoring for both men and women. The Commission was not impressed with this proposal.

FINANCIAL DATA

The Agency's leasing criteria established a \$1.00/sq.ft. minimum lease rate with higher offers to be considered in the selection process. Based upon proposals submitted, Unit A lease is for \$1.10/sq.ft.; Unit B lease is for \$1.25/sq.ft.; and the West Unit lease is for \$1.11/sq.ft. The term is for five years, beginning August 1, 1980 with one five year option to renew. An escalation clause is included in each lease effective at the beginning of the third year. It will be based upon the Consumer Price Index of the Oakland/San Francisco area with a maximum increase of 8 percent per year. (This was based on City of Sacramento leases for City owned garage retail space).

VOTE AND RECOMMENDATION OF COMMISSION

At its regular meeting of June 16, 1980, the Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Commission recommended "Sachet Beautiful Lingerie" (Jennifer Farr and Michael D. Schnyder) for Unit A; "Wee Petite", (Mr. and Mrs. James Abricki and Mr. and Mrs. Robert W. Johnson) for Unit B; and "The Filmworks", (Terry Matalone and Kenneth Miller) for the West Unit. The Commission also recommended the staff continue seeking a prestigious type tenant for the remaining prime space (east unit). The vote was recorded as follows:
