SUBJECT: Woodbine Street Improvements No. 5 (PN:TB26) - Resolution Approving
Negative Declaration

SUMMARY

The Environmental Coordinator finds that this project will not have a significant adverse effect on the physical environment and, therefore, recommends that the project and a Negative Declaration be approved by the City Council.

BACKGROUND

In accordance with the State EIR Guidelines for implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970, dated June 1986, an initial study was performed. As a result of this study, it was determined that the Woodbine Street Improvements No. 5 would not have a significant adverse effect on the physical environment, and a Draft Negative Declaration was prepared.

On January 7, 1986 the Negative Declaration was filed with the County Clerk. On February 23, 1987 Notice of Opportunity for Public Review of the Draft Negative Declaration was published in the Sacramento Union. The appropriate length of time has elapsed for comments regarding the Negative Declaration with no comments having been received.

The street improvements will cover a portion of Hing Avenue between Woodbine Avenue and 27th Street, a portion of 27th Street between Wah Avenue and Yreka Avenue, 57th Avenue between 27th Street and Carnation Avenue and Carnation Avenue between Wah Avenue and Yreka Avenue.

The street improvements will cover a portion of King Avenue between Woodbine Avenue and 27th Street, a portion of 27th Street between King Avenue and Yuba Avenue, 27th Avenue between 27th Street and Jackson Avenue and Corcoran Avenue between King Avenue and Yuba Avenue.


