SUBJECT: North Market Boulevard Extension - Resolution Approving Negative  
Declaration

SUMMARY

The Environmental Coordinator finds that this project will not have a significant adverse effect on the physical environment and, therefore, recommends that the project and a Negative Declaration be approved by the City Council.

BACKGROUND

In accordance with the State EIR Guidelines for implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970, dated June 1986, an initial study was performed. As a result of this study, it was determined that the North Market Boulevard Extension would not have a significant adverse effect on the physical environment, and a Draft Negative Declaration was prepared.

On May 12, 1987 the Negative Declaration was filed with the County Clerk. On May 14, 1987 Notice of Opportunity for Public Review of the Draft Negative Declaration was published in the Sacramento Union. The appropriate length of time has elapsed for comments regarding the Negative Declaration with no comments having been received.

The proposed North Market Boulevard extension is a part of the major internal circulation system required by the North Natomas Community Plan and will be designed to accommodate the anticipated traffic volume to ensure safe and efficient traffic movement throughout the community.

The Environmental Coordinator recommends that the attached resolution be passed which will:


1. Determine that the proposed project will not have a significant effect on the environment.


