SUBJECT: Access and Revenue Control Project - Recommendation for annulment of contract award to low bidder and award to second lowest bidder.

#### SUMMARY

This report recommends annulment of the contract award to ERI-Alton, the low bidder for the project, on the basis that this firm failed to execute the contract and furnish bonds as required. It is recommended that the contract be awarded to the next lowest bidder, Collins Electrical Co., Inc.

#### BACKGROUND INFORMATION

This project, as part of the City's Capital Improvement Program, was advertized for bids on July 8, 1981. A total of six bids were received on the bid due date of August 25, 1981. The bids were as follows:

On October 13, 1981, the Council awarded the contract to the low bidder, ERI-Alton, as recommended by the City Engineer. ERI has notified the City by letter of November 3, 1981, (attached) that it will not enter into the contract due to financial problems.

The next lowest bid for this project was submitted by Collins Electric, Inc., in the amount of \$672,000 (\$3,000 above the low bid from ERI-Alton). Collins Electrical, Inc. has been contacted and it has been confirmed that it will accept award of the contract.

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### FINANCIAL DATA

This is actually two projects combined for the purpose of expedience. One project is for Revenue Control Systems in Parking Facilities owned by SHRAC(lots K, O and R). The other project is for Revenue Control Systems in Parking Facilities owned by the Parking Authority (Lots A, B and H).

By letter agreement of February 19, 1981, SHRA has authorized \$423,000 for this project. There was \$232,055 appropriated from the Parking Authority from two years ago when the Council approved this project for the City's Capital Improvement Program. The low bid from ERI-Alton varied with budgeted funds as follows:

The next lowest bid, from Collins Electric, requires \$32,000 less than what was appropriated for the Parking Authority's part of the project and \$35,000 more than what was appropriated for SHRA's part of the project, as shown in the following tabulation:

A total of \$3,000 will be withheld from the corporate surety bond submitted by the low bidder in order to compensate for the overall difference in the low bid and next to lowest bid.

#### RECOMMENDATION

The City Engineer recommends the following:

- That the attached Resolution annulling the contract award to ERI-Alton and awarding same to Collins: Electrical Co., Inc. be adopted.
- 2. That the City Council adopt the attached resolution, repealing Resolution No. CC 81-744, and appropriating \$407,400 from the Housing and Redevelopment Capital Improvement Fund.
- 3. That the Parking Authority adopt the attached Resolution, repealing Resolution No. PA 81002, and appropriating \$66,145 for this project out of the Parking Authority Fund.
