**SUBJECT: RESOLUTION PROHIBITING PARKING DURING CERTAIN HOURS AROUND
MAX BAER PARK**

LOCATION: 34th Avenue, 35th Avenue, Wilkinson Street, and 79th Street

COUNCIL DISTRICTS: 6

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council adopt the attached resolution to prohibit parking during certain hours on the following streets located adjacent to Max Baer Park.

- 34th Avenue, south side, from Wilkinson Street to 79th Street
- 35th Avenue, north side, from Wilkinson Street to 79th Street
- Wilkinson Street, east side, from 34th Avenue to 35th Avenue
- 79th Street, west side, from 34th Avenue to 35th Avenue

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Police Department, in response to problems associated with parking around Max Baer park, has requested that parking on the streets around the park be prohibited during the night time hours. Max Baer Park is located in the southeast area of Sacramento near the intersection of Wilkenson Street and Fruitridge Road. This park has been the source of increasing police calls. The park has been a meeting place for drinking, drug deals, and gang related activity during the nighttime hours.

The Police Department conducted a neighborhood survey of the twenty-one households which surround the park. The survey indicated that speeding vehicles and drinking are major problems. These problems increase during the nighttime hours. The Police Department District Officers and area residents state that drinking, playing loud music, and associated problems have become a nuisance to the people in the neighborhood and made the park and the streets surrounding the park unsafe for neighbors to use. Nineteen of the twenty-one households are in favor of the streets surrounding the park being posted "no parking" during park closure hours (sunset to sunrise).

Posting the streets around the park as "no parking" will reduce the number of outsiders into the area and help restore Max Baer Park to its intended purpose.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

The cost to implement the recommended parking regulations is \$800 for the installation of regulatory signing. Funds are available in the 91/93 On-Street Parking operational budget (101-310-3124-4471).

POLICY CONSIDERATION

This recommendation is consistent with Sacramento City Code 25.103, which prohibits parking during certain hours on streets described in resolutions adopted by City Council.

MBE/WBE

Installation of the signs will be done by City staff. Procurement of materials will be in accordance with the City's MBE/WBE policy.



A RESOLUTION PROHIBITING PARKING DURING CERTAIN HOURS AROUND MAX BAER PARK

Whereas, when authorized signs are in place giving notice thereof, no person shall stop, stand or park on the days indicated on such signs, between the hours specified on such signs, upon any of the streets described in resolutions duly adopted by the City Council.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

The following streets shall be regulated by "No Parking from Sunset to Sunrise":

- 34th Avenue, south side, from Wilkinson Street to 79th Street.
- 35th Avenue, north side, from Wilkinson Street to 79th Street.
- Wilkinson Street, east side, from 34th Avenue to 35th Avenue.
- 79th Street, west side, from 34th Avenue to 35th Avenue.

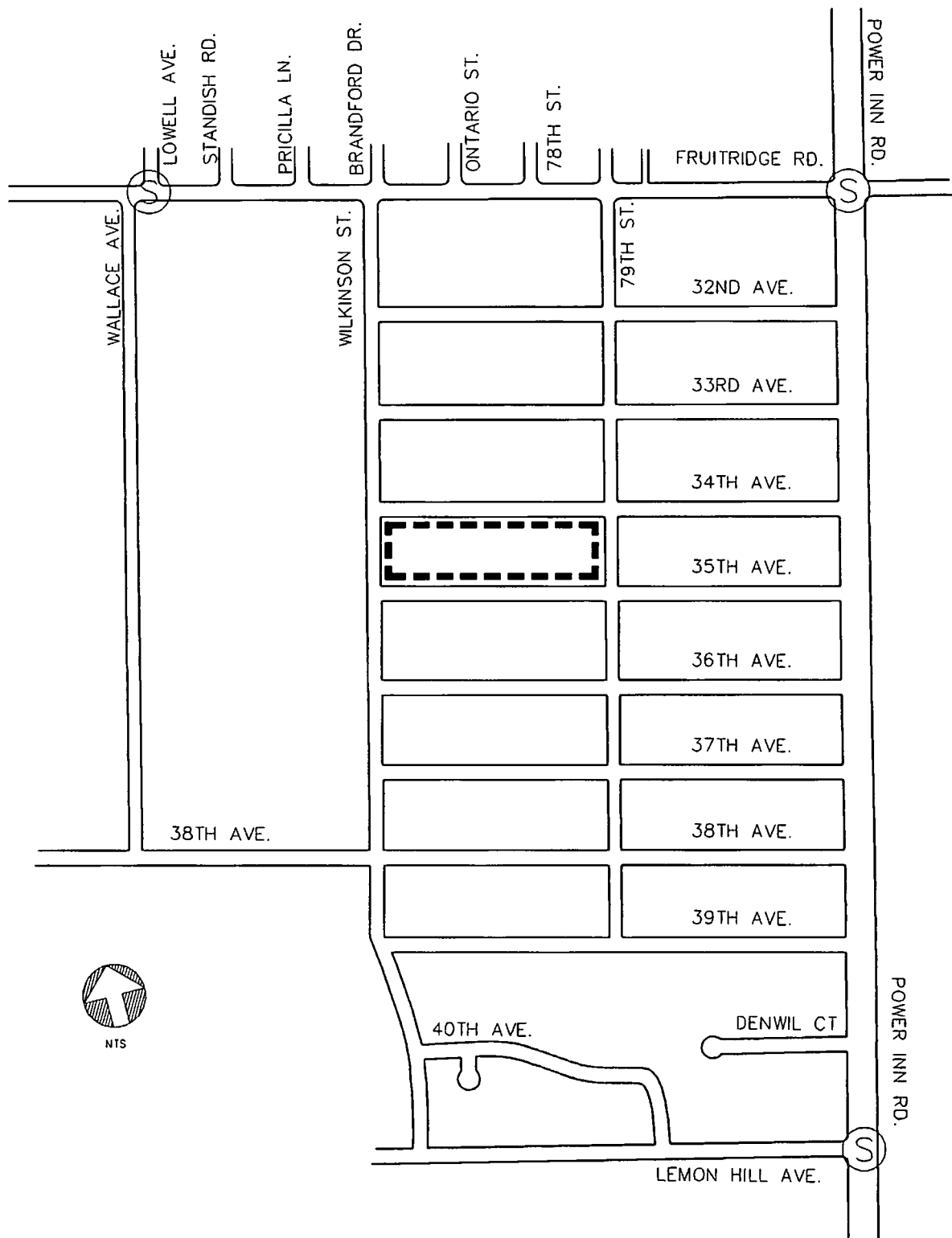
