The Civil Service Board of the City of Sacramento met in special session on the above date at 7:10 o'clock P.M. in the office of the City Manager, City Hall, Vice President Chenu presiding.

PRESENT: Commissioners Chenu, Weisman.
ABSENT: Commissioner Mason.

Minutes of special meeting of October 30th, 1928, were read and approved as read.

It was the sense of the meeting that all matters pending before the Board, with the exception of reviewing the papers of the Police and Fire Department applicants, be deferred until the next meeting.

The Board thereupon proceeded to open the envelopes of candidates for patrolmen and uniform firemen covering educational tests held November 26th and 27th.

Upon motion by Commissioner Weisman, seconded by Commissioner Chenu and unanimously carried, meeting was set for 8:30 o'clock P.M., Tuesday, December 18th, in the Council Chamber of the City Hall for the purpose of conducting personal fitness tests for successful candidates for patrolman and uniform fireman and the Secretary was instructed to notify those applicants who had passed the educational test to be in attendance at the above time and place, and to notify those applicants who had received less than a passing grade of 70 per cent in the educational test that they had failed in such examination.

Adjournment was taken at 8 o'clock P.M.
