

ORDINANCE NO. 366, FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A PLANNING COMMISSION IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THE CALIFORNIA PLANNING ACT, THE SAME BEING CHAPTER 874 OF THE STATUTES OF 1927, REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 288, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED JUNE 10th, 1926.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: There is hereby created a Planning Commission of the City of Sacramento under and pursuant to the provisions of the California Planning Act of 1927, the same being Chapter 874 of the Statutes of 1927, to consist of six (6) members to be appointed by the Mayor, with the approval of the City Council, and to hold office as provided by said Planning Act, and also the following ex-officio members, to-wit: The Mayor, the City Engineer, and the City Attorney.

SECTION 2: Said Planning Commission shall have all of the powers and duties prescribed by said Planning Act of 1927, and as prescribed by all other laws of the State of California and ordinances of the City of Sacramento, and shall succeed the present planning board created by Ordinance No. 288, Fourth Series, and shall dispose of all matters now pending before said Board.

SECTION 3: Ordinance No. 288, Fourth Series, passed June 10th, 1926, is hereby repealed.
