**SUBJECT: Acceptance of Miller Park Launching Area Improvement Grant**

**LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:**

Miller Park is located in District 1.

**SUMMARY**

This report provides information regarding a grant in the amount of \$210,000 awarded to the Department of Parks and Community Services for improvements to the boat launching ramp at Miller Park.

**STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that the City Council approve, by resolution, amendment of the 1991-1996 Capital Improvement Program Budget to include the Miller Park Launching Area Improvements and the allocation of grant funds in the amount of \$210,000 to the project.

**BACKGROUND**

On May 1, 1990, the City Council authorized the filing of a grant application for \$210,000 for the improvement of boat launching facilities at Miller Park from the State of California, Department of Boating and Waterways.

Miller Park offers numerous waterfront activities including a 553-berth marina, concession stand, courtesy launching ramp, parking lot, rest room, and picnic areas. Miller Park is an extremely popular site for boating and fishing activities throughout the year. The boat launching ramp at Miller Park is utilized by an estimated 6,000 boaters and fishing enthusiasts each year.

The project to be funded by this grant consists of extending and improving the existing launching ramp, adding additional lighting, fire plug, boarding floats, signage and paving repairs. These facility improvements will provide a safer and a more convenient water access for small craft boaters and fishermen. Additional lighting will provide enhanced safety to boaters in the early morning and late evening hours. The project will begin in the Spring of 1992.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

This report allocates \$210,000 to the CIP budget for the Miller Park Boat Launch Improvement Project (248-500-XXXX).


POLICY CONSIDERATIONS




