SUBJECT: Naming the Colonial Park Softball Diamond "Bob Teeple Field"

SUMMARY

The Colonial-Parks and Recreation Effort, C.A.R.E. is requesting the naming of the softball diamond at Colonial Park "Bob Teeple Field" in honor of Mr. Teeple, who has actively been involved in improvements to the Colonial Park site. A brief background of Bob Teeple's services to the community park and a recommendation is included herein.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Bob has actively participated in the Little League program in the Colonial Park area and held the position of equipment manager for a number of years.

As a resident of the community and a member of the C.A.R.E. organization, he has provided a variety of improvements to Colonial Park. These include rewiring the storage room, providing nets and installing fittings for the volleyball posts. He was instrumental in the installation of the flag pole and memorial plaque at the site, and provided the Colonial Park bulletin board. He has worked closely with C.A.R.E. in overseeing the parks and its problems.

Bob has developed a following of youth in the neighborhood, many of whom continue to stop by his residency to visit.

FINANCIAL DATA

With Council approval, the organization will provide a sign designating the softball diamond as "Bob Teeple Field". The sign will meet all specifications by the City.

RECOMMENDATION


It is recommended that the City Council, by resolution, approve the request of C.A.R.E. to name the softball diamond at Colonial Park in honor of Bob Teeple.
