Subject: Haggin Oaks Fairway #13 Pedestrian Bridge - CIP #0A41

SUMMARY

This report requests authorization to award a single source bid in an amount not to exceed \$12,000 to Continental Custom Bridge Company for the construction of a prefabricated bridge over Arcade Creek on Fairway #13 of the Haggin Oaks Golf Course. Additionally, this report requests authorization to use an informal bid process to construct the bridge footings and place the bridge.

No additional City funds are requested.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Arcade Creek is being realigned to minimize interference with play on Fairway #13 at Haggin Oaks Golf Course CIP #0A41. A pedestrian bridge will be necessary to cross Arcade Creek between the tee and the green on a portion of the existing Arcade Creek. It is necessary to have this bridge complete before the start of winter or the fairway will not be accessible for play.

There are two bridge Companies that construct prefabricated bridges of the type needed for this project. One company uses laminated wood beams and one company supplies steel bridges. This bridge will be under water during rainy season and it has been decided that the steel bridge would last longer in this particular location. Staff feels that the steel bridge manufactured by Continental Custom Bridge is the only bridge suitable for this site. The manufacturing and delivery time for the bridge is twelve weeks plus nine weeks for construction. The bid process for normal competitive bidding would not allow sufficient time to construct the bridge before winter. For this reason, staff requests authorization to award a single source bid to Continental Custom Bridge Company.

The manufacturer of the bridge will provide the department with plans for construction of the bridge footings. Staff requests authorization to use an informal bid process to construct the footings and install the bridge for an estimated cost of \$15,000. The footings will be advertized for bid as soon as the manufacturer of the bridge receives notice to proceed and provides staff with construction drawings for the footings.

FINANCIAL DATA

No additional City funds are requested.

Funding in the amount of \$35,000 for the Haggin Oaks Fairway #13 project was appropriated in the FY 1986-87 Golf Division Capital Improvement Program (CIP #0A41) from the Golf Fund.

RECOMMENDATION


It is recommended that the Budget and Finance Committee review this report and refer it to the full City Council for approval. Further, it is recommended that the Council, by resolution, authorize the Golf Division of the Department of Parks and Community Services to 1) award a single source bid in an amount not to exceed \$12,000 to Continental Custom Bridge Company for a prefabricated steel bridge and 2) solícite informal bids and award to the low bidder, a contract to construct bridge footings and plan said bridge for a bid price not to exceed \$15,000.
