

ORDINANCE NO. 82-052

ADOPTED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL ON DATE OF

JUN 29 1992

ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AN EXEMPTION FROM ARTICLE III
OF CHAPTER 12 FOR SPECIAL EVENTS IN SUPPORT OF
CITY PROGRAMS AND FACILITIES AND DECLARING SAID
ORDINANCE TO BE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE
EFFECT IMMEDIATELY

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1

Section 12.65 is hereby added to the Code of the City of Sacramento as follows:

Sec. 12.65 Exemption for special events in support of City facilities
and programs.

This article shall not apply to the use of City-owned property for the sale of food, beverages or merchandise in connection with a special event conducted by a non-profit organization which is held to support a City program or facility. This exemption shall apply only to special events of less than sixty (60) days duration upon approval in advance by the Director of Community Services. "Non-profit organization" means any group or persons associated for religious, scientific, literary, educational, recreational, benevolent or other purpose not of pecuniary profit.

SECTION 2.

Subsection (d) of Section 27.50 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 27.50 Park Use Regulations

No person shall

(d) Engage in any commercial activity in any park, except a nonprofit organization pursuant to a fund raising permit therefor or pursuant to a lease or concession contract issued under Chapter 12 of the City Code or pursuant to any exemption to Chapter 12.



SECTION 3.


This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure to take effect immediately. The reason for the emergency is the need for the exemption created by Section 1 to be effective immediately so that food, beverages and merchandise can be sold at special events benefiting the City which are scheduled to commence in early July, 1982.
