AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE SACRAMENTO CITY CODE
BY ADDING SECTION 19.122-1
RELATING TO DISABLED EXEMPTIONS

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1.

Section 19.122-1 is hereby added to Chapter 19 of the Sacramento City Code to read as follows:

19.122-1 Disabled Exemption - Notwithstanding any other provisions of this Chapter or any other provision of the City Code to the contrary, an exemption from placing a receptacle at curbside as described in the second paragraph of 19.122 may be made, upon approval of an application to the solid waste division, to certain service users. The requestor must attest that he/she is physically and financially unable to cause a full waste container to move to the curb and that there is no one else in the house who is able to move a full waste container to the curb. The Director of Public Works or his/her designee is authorized to implement City Council approved standards, terms, and conditions for said exemptions. The exemption provided for in this section shall be applied for on a form prescribed by the City and will allow the recipient to receive in-yard service for the applicable curbside fee as established by resolution of the City Council.
