SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN INCREASE IN THE LIBRARY'S

BUDGET BY \$1,000, THE AMOUNT RECEIVED AS A GIFT FROM WESTERN

SOLAR UTILIZATION NETWORK

SUMMARY:

In October 1980, the Western Solar Utilization Network (Western SUN) contacted the Sacramento Public Library and offered to provide \$1,000 as part of a project to encourage the use of solar energy in the City of Sacramento. The City-County Librarian acknowledged the offer and accepted for the Sacramento Public Library under authorization by the City Council in 1976, to accept donations of no more than \$2,000, such donations to become the property of the City of Sacramento.

BACKGROUND:

Western Sun is one of four Regional Solar Energy Centers funded by the U.S. Department of Energy. Each center's task is to encourage the use of solar energy within its specific region. The purpose of the project is to strengthen the solar collection of the libraries so that individuals seeking information will have a source of reference for practical application of solar energy.

FUNDING:

The sum of \$1,000 has been received and will cover the purchase by the Library Department of 58 titles on solar energy to be added to the collection at Central Library, 828 I Street. There is no obligation on the part of the City of Sacramento in the acquisition of this material except to provide administration of the funds as Fiscal Agent.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is therefore recommended that your Council approve the attached resolution authorizing an increase in the Library budget of \$1,000.
