

ORDINANCE NO 384 , FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE DISTRICTS ESTABLISHED BY PROVISIONS OF ORDINANCE NO. 117, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED APRIL 19th, 1923; AND ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE DIVISION OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO INTO FIVE DISTRICTS AND PRESCRIBING THE USE TO WHICH PROPERTY IN THE SAID SEVERAL DISTRICTS MAY BE PUT AND MAKING CERTAIN RESTRICTIONS UPON THE USE THEREOF; FURTHER PROVIDING FOR THE MAXIMUM HEIGHT TO WHICH BUILDINGS MAY HEREAFTER BE ERECTED; DEFINING THE TERMS USED HEREIN AND PRESCRIBING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THE PROVISIONS HEREOF, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY," BY REMOVING CERTAIN TERRITORY FROM THE SECOND RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT AND PLACING THE SAME IN THE LIGHT INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT AS PRESCRIBED BY THE PROVISIONS OF SAID ORDINANCE NO. 117, FOURTH SERIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The territory hereinafter described, which is included in the Second Residential District as established by provisions of Ordinance No. 117, Fourth Series, is hereby removed from said Second Residential District and placed in the Light Industrial District, to-wit:


Lots Numbered Four (4), Five (5), Six (6), and Seven (7) of Highland Park; excepting therefrom the northerly Ten (10) feet, said lots being situated on the south side of Y Street between 23rd and 24th Streets.

SECTION 2. The City Clerk of the City of Sacramento is hereby directed to change the maps, which are a part of said Ordinance No. 117, Fourth Series, to conform to the provisions of this Ordinance.


