SUBJECT: Revocable Encroachment Permit - Chinese Community Church

SUMMARY:

The Chinese Community Church has applied for a revocable encroachment permit for the purpose of planting ground cover and constructing irrigation system. The City Engineer recommends that the permit be granted.

BACKGROUND:

The area for which this request is being made consists of an area adjacent to 5600 GilgunnWay used as roadway embankment for Fruitridge Road. County Assessors' Parcel Number 017-233-01.

RESOLUTION GRANTING REVOCABLE ENCROACHMENT TO:
Chinese Community Church

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That a revocable encroachment permit for the purpose of

Planting Ground Cover and Constructing Irrigation System

is hereby granted to Chinese Community Church , whose address is as follows: 5600 Gilgumn Way, Sacramento, Ca. 95821 .

The encroachment area is described as follows: An area adjacent to $5600~{\rm Gilgu}_{\rm nn}\,{\rm Way}$ used as roadway embankment for Fruitridge Road. APN 017-233-01.

This permit is granted subject to the "General Provisions - Revocable Encroachment Permit", which were adopted by the City Council in Resolution No. 77-611, dated October 4, 1977, and the hereinafter specified special conditions, if any. This permit shall be effective only after the applicant files with the Department of Finance of the City of Sacramento, the insurance certificates required by the General Provisions.


SPECIAL CONDITIONS

- 1. The Permittee shall comply with all requirements of the City Planning Department, Building Inspections Division and the City sign ordinance.
- 2. Liability Insurance (Itme No. 21) is hereby waived.
- 3. Permittee shall maintain all facilities and landscaping granted by this permit to the satisfaction of the City Engineer.
- 4. All shrubs and plant species shall be approved by the City prior to installation. No trees shall be permitted.
- 5. The existing asphalt sidewalk at the top of the embankment shall not be disturbed.
