SUBJECT: Revised Agreement for the Distribution of Parking Citation

Proceeds Between the City and the County

SUMMARY

The County has determined that their processing costs for parking citations exceeds the 21% they have been withholding. They have arranged changes in the bail schedule, making it possible to increase their revenues without reducing ours.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

For many years, the County has withheld 21% of the parking citation revenues to cover their cost of processing. About a year ago, they determined that this was not enough money to cover their costs. Several meetings were held to work an equitable solution to the problem. It was agreed that the County would send a request to the Municipal Court Judges to modify the bail schedule. As of September 1, the bail schedule was modified to increase the \$4 citations to \$5, increase the notice fee from \$2 to \$3, and institute a new fee equal to the original bail for all citations forwarded to the Department of Motor Vehicles. The attached Agreement sets up a new formula for distributing the proceeds between the City and the County. It provides that the County will retain 21% of the original bail, all of the notice fee and 21% of the new fees for those citations transmitted to the Department of Motor Vehicles.

FINANCIAL DATA

It is estimated that the new fees and the new distribution will increase the County's revenues by about \$190,000 and increase the City's

revenues by about \$150,000, providing there is no change in the public characteristics of paying parking citations.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the attached Resolution authorizing the Mayor to sign the new Agreement between the City and the County be adopted.
