SUBJECT: Resurfacing Tennis Courts at Reichmuth, Warren and Robertson Parks  
(PN:LC01) - Contract Award

SUMMARY

This project has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and contract award is recommended.

BACKGROUND

This project is a portion of the continuing program to resurface existing tennis courts. The tennis courts at Reichmuth, Warren and Robertson Parks are next on the priority list for resurfacing.

On June 9, 1987 the City Council approved the plans and specifications for this project. Bids were received and opened by the City Clerk on June 30, 1987. The bids received were:

Malott & Peterson - Grundy	\$15,800.00
Precision Painting	18,900.00
A & B Asphalt Sealing Co.	24,150.00

The Landscape Architect's estimated construction cost was \$16,000. The estimated project completion date is March 1, 1988.

FINANCIAL

Sufficient funds are available for this project. The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design and construction costs, is \$28,000. The current budget is \$28,000, which was approved in the Capital Improvement Program with \$15,000 from General Funds and \$13,000 from Quimby Act Funds.




RECOMMENDATION
