

ORDINANCE NO. 491, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THAT PRESENTATION OF CLAIMS FOR MONEY OR DAMAGES AGAINST THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO BE MADE; AND PRESCRIBING THE PERIOD OF TIME IN WHICH SUCH CLAIMS MUST BE PRESENTED:

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. No suit shall be brought on any claim for money or damages against the City of Sacramento or any officer or board of the City until a demand for the same has been presented as herein provided, and rejected in whole or in part. If rejected in part, suit may be brought to recover the whole. Except in those cases where a shorter period of time is otherwise provided by law, all claims for damages against the City must be presented within six (6) months after the occurrence from which the damages arose, and all other claims or demands shall be presented within six (6) months after the last item of the account or claim accrued.
