**SUBJECT:** STATE ROUTE 160 BIKEWAY PROJECT - SUTTERVILLE ROAD TO MEADOWVIEW ROAD (PN:HA86) - APPROVE PROGRAM SUPPLEMENT NO. 055 AND APPROPRIATE FUNDS IN AN AMOUNT OF \$277,000

**LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:** South Sacramento in Council Districts No. 4, 5 & 8

**RECOMMENDATION:**

This report recommends that the City Council adopt the attached resolution which approves Program Supplement No. 055 with Caltrans and appropriates Federal and State funds in an amount of \$277,000 to the State Route 160 Bikeway Project - Sutterville Road to Meadowview Road.

**SUMMARY:**

This report recommends the following:

- That Program Supplement No. 055 with Caltrans be approved.
- That appropriation of Federal and State funds in an amount of \$277,000 to the State Route 160 Bikeway Project - Sutterville Road to Meadowview Road (PN:HA86) be approved.

The project will encourage bicycle usage, and improve bicycle access within the City as well as achieve the Council's goal of increasing public safety and transportation mobility within the City.

**COMMITTEE/COMMISSION ACTION:**

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

On June 29, 1993, the City Council approved projects, for consideration in Phase II of the Federal Intermodal Surface Transportation Efficiency Act (ISTEA) program.

This project, along with other projects submitted by the City and other agencies in the County, was subsequently approved for funding by both the Sacramento Transportation Authority (STA) and by the Sacramento Area Council of Governments (SACOG). SACOG forwarded the project to Caltrans, who is responsible for appropriating Federal funds to projects.

In order to be eligible to receive Federal funds, it is necessary for the City to execute a program supplement to the Master Local Agency - State Agreement.

The project improvements are as follows:

- Construct a Class II bikeway on State Route 160 between Sutterville Road and Meadowview Road.
- Purchase and install twenty (20) bicycle lockers at Sacramento City College.
- Sign and stripe approximately 62 miles of existing on-street bike lanes to Class II standards.

The project is consistent with the City's Bikeway Master Plan.

With the exception of City indirect and overhead charges, the project is 100% funded by Federal ISTEA and State Transportation Systems Management (TSM) funds.

The project is scheduled for bid advertising in 1995.

**FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

This project, with the exception of City indirect and overhead charges, is 100% funded by Federal ISTEAs and State TSM funds. The amount of Program Supplement No. 055 is \$277,000 which is the estimated total project cost. The existing project budget of \$66,500 will cover the City's indirect and overhead costs.


**POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:**

## RESOLUTION APPROVING PROGRAM SUPPLEMENT NO. 055 AND APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS FOR THE STATE ROUTE 160 BIKEWAY PROJECT - SUTTERVILLE ROAD TO MEADOWVIEW ROAD (PN:HA86)

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO THAT:

1. Program Supplement No. 055 with Caltrans in an amount of \$277,000 is hereby approved.
2. The Federal Capital Grant Revenue Budget (511-500-HA86-3598) be increased in the amount of \$221,600 to reflect Federal ISTE A fund participation for the State Route 160 Bikeway Project - Sutterville Road to Meadowview Road (PN:HA86).
3. The State Capital Grant Revenue Budget (512-500-HA86-3598) be increased in the amount of \$55,400 to reflect State TSM fund participation for the State Route 160 Bikeway Project - Sutterville Road to Meadowview Road (PN:HA86).
4. That \$221,600 in Federal and \$55,400 in State funds be appropriated to the State Route 160 Bikeway Project - Sutterville Road to Meadowview Road as follows:
