Application and Acceptance of California Volunteers, Youth Service Corps Big 13 Grant

BACKGROUND

- A. In June 2022, the City accepted a CaliforniansForAll Youth Service Corps grant in the amount of \$6,980,080 from the State of California's "California Volunteers" office, which is within the Office of the Governor. That grant expired on September 30, 2024.
- B. In December 2023, the State of California released a Notice of Funding Availability for a second round of CaliforniansForAll Youth Service Corps funding to provide opportunities for youth and young adults to be hired in the workforce.
- C. On January 23, 2024, City Council authorized the City Manager to apply for \$2,874,428 in grant funding for the second round of the Youth Service Corps program (formerly known as CaliforniansForAll). The State of California subsequently awarded that amount to the City, and on May 28, 2024, the City Council accepted such award of \$2,874,428.
- D. On May 7, 2025, the State of California notified the City of an additional award of Youth Service Corps Round 2 funding in the amount of \$3,030,876, for a total award of \$5,905,304.
- E. The City's Office of Innovation and Economic Development is now seeking approval to apply for the California Volunteers 2025-2026 Youth Service Corps Big 13 Program. The funds would be used to continue the City's Youth Service Corps – Young Adult Work Experience Program.
- F. The City of Sacramento is eligible to apply for up to \$2,472,252 for youth and young adult workforce programs.
- G. There is no match requirement for the California Volunteers 2025-2026 Youth Service Corps Big 13 Program grant.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1.

The City Manager or designee is authorized to apply for and submit all necessary documentation for grant funding in the amount of \$2,472,252 from California Volunteers 2025-2026 Youth Service Corps Big 13 Program.

SECTION 2.

If the City's application for California Volunteers 2025-2026 Youth Service Corps Big 13 Program funding is approved, the City Manager or designee is authorized to accept funding in an amount of up to \$2,472,252.

SECTION 3.

The City Manager or designee is authorized to increase the revenue and expenditure budgets in the Youth Services Corps Grant Project (G02180370) by \$2,472,252 (Operating Grants, Fund 2702).

SECTION 4.

If the City's application for California Volunteers 2025-2026 Youth Service Corps Big 13 Program funding is approved, an agreement with the State of California will be brought back to the City Council for approval and City Council approval will be sought for any related documents necessary for receipt of grant funding from the State of California.
