### SUMMARY

The Division of Water and Sewers has prepared plans and specifications for the subject project. Copies of said plans and specifications have been forwarded to the City Clerk and approval is recommended.

### BACKGROUND

The Sacramento River Water Treatment Plant was constructed in the early 1920's with a total of eight sand filters (numbers 1 thru 8). Filters numbers 9 thru 16 were added in the late 1930's. In 1965, a surface wash system was installed in filters numbers 1 thru 8. A surface wash system scours the top surface of each filter thereby loosening accumulated mud and silt providing more effective backwash cleaning of the filters. Without a surface wash system, filters numbers 9 thru 16 have been plagued with a build-up of mud balls which requires manual removal. This project will eliminate the need for manual removal of mud balls by providing the necessary scouring action on the surface of each filter.

### FINANCIAL DATA

Funds for this project will be provided by transferring \$170,000 from the FY 83/84 Water Production Capital Improvements Budget, Sacramento Water Treatment Plant Expansion, 4-13-3152-1501-4820, to Surface Wash at Sacramento Water Treatment Plant, 4-13-3152-1553-4820 (see attached resolution).

### RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the plans and specifications and the attached resolution be adopted, and that bids be received on August 30, 1983.



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
