SUBJECT: Sump 101 Outfall Structure Reconstruction (PN:WB06) - Contract Award

SUMMARY

This project has been advertised for bids. One bid has been received and contract award is recommended.

BACKGROUND

This project is a portion of the overall program to repair the damage to drainage facilities that occurred during the floods of 1986. Sump 101 is located on the American River levee, just upstream of the H Street Bridge on the left bank of the river. The project will replace the outfall structure and restore the levee bank to its condition prior to the flooding.

On September 2, 1986 the City Council approved the plans and specifications for this project. One bid was received and opened by the City Clerk on September 16, 1986. The bid received was:

D.C.M. Construction	\$66,330
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Even though the bid of D.C.M. Construction was the only bid received, it is believed to be the best bid available at this time.

The engineer's estimated construction cost was \$67,000. The estimated project completion date is November 5, 1986.

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
FINANCIAL


RECOMMENDATION
