Proposed Relinquishment of State Highway Route 16

SUMMARY:

This report recommends the adoption of the attached resolution accepting the conditional relinquishment of State Route 16 from the centerline of the I Street bridge to the vicinity of 3rd and I Streets.

BACKGROUND:

The California Transportation Commission recently included in the State Transportation Improvement Program the last of a series of highway construction projects that would bring an end to State responsibility to maintain State Route 16 between Sacramento and Woodland.

Route 16 between Woodland and the Elkhorn Bridge has already been relinquished to Yolo County. The California Transportation Commission is now proposing completion of the last project on the substitute Route 84 in Broderick on the condition that the remainder of Route 16 in this area be relinquished; that is, from Elkhorn to the vicinity of I-5 in Sacramento.

Yolo County has, by resolution, agreed to accept the proposed relinguishment. Before Caltrans would advertise the completion of the Route 84 project, concurrence of all affected agencies must be accomplished. Actual relinquishment of Route 16 to local agencies would be deferred until the projects completion (expected in late 1982).

FINANCIAL:

This action will result in some additional cost to the City. estimated the total additional maintenance cost will be approximately \$8,200 per year. This includes a payment to the Southern Pacific Transportation Company of \$1,500 per year for maintenance of the I Street Bridge across the Sacramento River. This payment is in accordance with an existing agreement dating back to the vear 1910.
